Itineration Report:

April 20, 2003

What joy to celebrate once again the resurrection of our Lord and Savior Jesus Christ! May He bless each one of you with His presence and care. While this newsletter will reach you all several days after Easter, we trust our prayers have touched Heaven for you at this writing!



40 services in five states in 79 days...approx. 14,000 miles.

We have had a wonderful time on the itineration trail, and while it has been a bit exhausting at times, it has been very rewarding. What a blessing to meet so many of God's people, and gain so many wonderful new friends.

We had the opportunity to hold mission services in five states (CA, AZ, CO, NM and TX), attend one campmeeting, and preach two revivals from January through March. Approximately 14,000 miles later into itineration, we are now itinerating in the central states, but more on that later.

We had some very wonderful and powerful services during this time, all glory to Jesus' name! Thanks for your prayers during this time of extensive travel. It is our prayer and continued desire that we are a blessing to the churches during this time.

Support Update:

It has been exciting watching the Lord provide every need. We are now at 23% of our budget in pledged

monthly support. We know we have a long way to go but we are confident that we are in the center of God's will, and assured of His provision through His people.

How sweet it is to trust in Jesus, and how privileged we are to do His will!



Field Report: Caracas, Venezuela

We are investigating the apartment market now, and I will most likely be taking a trip to Caracas shortly to begin the renting process. Please pray for God's direction in this matter.

We continue to be so grateful to veteran missionaries Chuck and Kim Akers for all they've done in helping us. We plan to be working directly with them for the first year of our return to Caracas to assist them in the barrio work, and hopefully give them a chance to return to the States for a time of itineration.

Amazon Rainforest

The doors continue to open to us for jungle ministry, and we continue to learn more of the Indians' culture and ways. We are looking to build an outstation along the Orinoco River in 2005, and will keep you posted on future developments. With the overwhelming response to the message of holiness and purity, we are preparing to train the Indian pastors and leaders, and are compiling and translating material for this effort. Pray for God's leading as we seek a suitable base for missions work among the Indians.

Did You Know:

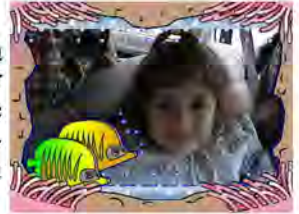
- Venezuela boasts a population of over 23 million people.
