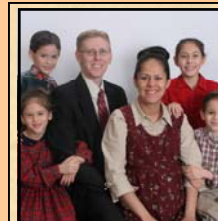

Before you can even think of what to do, screams erupt all around you. You search frantically in the direction of the cacophony.

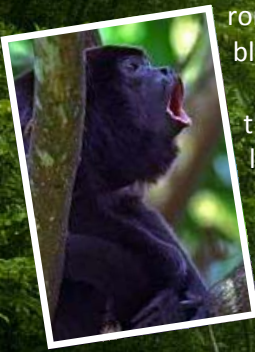


Now, the screams are quickly moving your way. Ever nearer they come and you know that you must stay on the jungle trail to avoid getting lost.

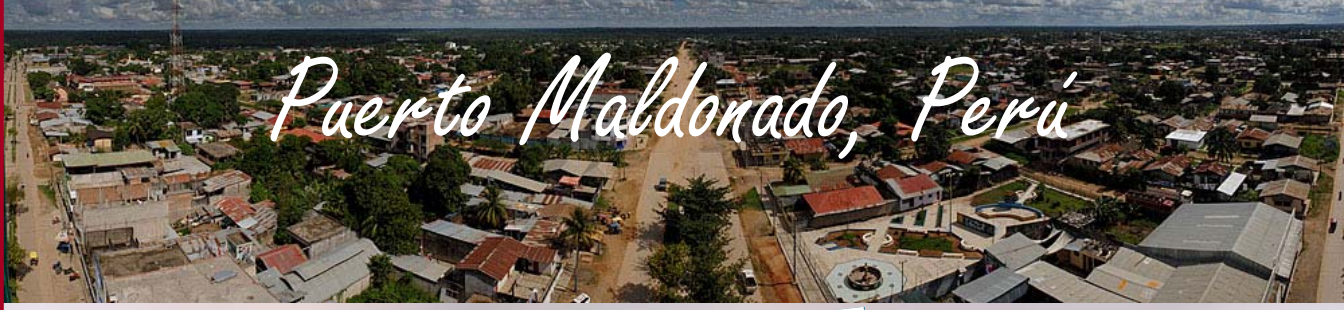

Puerto Maldonado, Perú



The town of Puerto Maldonado is located deep in the Amazon Rainforest in southern Perú on the banks of the lumbering Madre de Dios River.

The town itself is a hodge-podge of mostly dilapidated houses with rusty tin roofs amid dusty roads, yet the town is surrounded by pristine jungle beauty.

A strategic center for missions work because of the access it provides to the region, we are moving our family to this town and intend to work from there as a mission base to the surrounding tribal groups and scattered villages.

Our developing strategy is two-fold:

1. To provide **training to pastors and churches** already established in the town and neighboring hamlets, and work toward **mobilizing them toward home missions**, and
2. To conduct **pioneer evangelism** in the surrounding area. Our hope and major challenge is **to make contact with one or more of the various unreached semi-nomadic tribes** widely scattered around the area to bring them the Gospel and attempt church-planting.



Puerto Maldonado is located along the Madre de Dios River near the Bolivian border

The following are a few prayer requests along and an opportunity to give:

- Pray for our move and consider giving toward our moving costs from the capital to Puerto Maldonado, and for the purchase of much needed equipment.
- Pray that God will lead us to adequate available housing for rent at a price within our budget.
- Pray for our family's health and wellness as we adjust to a new climate and are exposed to malaria, yellow fever & other health risks.
- Please pray for our children's overall adjustment.
